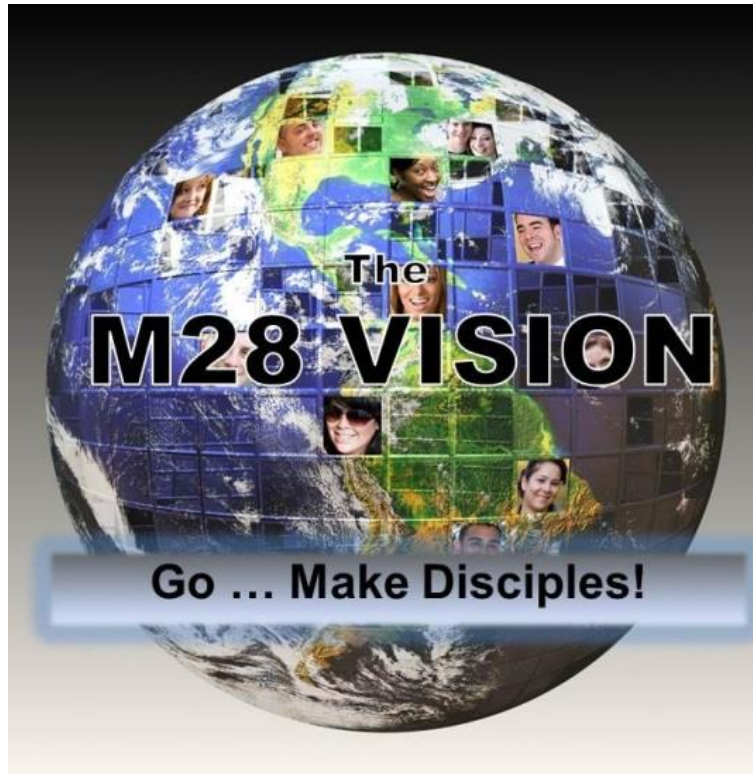


Year One Progress Report 2016



The M28 Mandate

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:18-20.

The M28 Target : 2022

M28 is a seven-year vision of goals reaching to 2022.

- Intervals of seven years have a deep biblical foundation.
- In biblical terms, 2022 would mark the completion of seven cycles of seven years, - the biblical year of Jubilee for Anastasia Baptist Church.
- Strategically coincides with the 50th Anniversary of Anastasia Baptist Church.

M28 VISION: Go

Goal 1: Send at least 500 individuals to share Jesus statewide and/or nationally and/or internationally.

Progress: In this first year, we have sent 138 different individuals in 9 countries (Moldova, Canada, Haiti, Nicaragua, France, India, Montana, Kenya, Cuba), and 4 states (Florida, South Carolina, Indiana, Alabama).

Goal 2: Sending and/or supporting at least 10 national and international mission partnerships. A partnership is a relationship with believers in another place where we are focused for two or more years spreading the good news of Jesus Christ by either 1) sending mission teams, 2) supporting missionaries on the field, or 3) planting new churches.

Progress: Currently we have 8 partnerships (Canada, Moldova, Nicaragua, France, Haiti, Montana, Kenya, and Cuba. We have a developing partnership in the Assam region of India.

Goal 3: Supporting the start of 7 new churches in North America or around the world.

Progress: We have supported 2 church starts

Possible church starts in Haiti and India are being planned.

Goal 4: Send at least 1,000 individuals to share Jesus in the community through community ministry partnerships, local mission action, and sharing the gospel.

Progress: We have sent over 400+ different individuals throughout the community. The numbers represented below add to over 400 people because of people involved in multiple projects.

Goal 5: Sending out believers to begin 2 new congregations in St. Johns County.

Progress: Life Groups in the area of Elkton have been started.

Goal 6: Sharing the gospel at least 50,000 times.

Progress: We have recorded over 2,000 gospel presentations. Focus in 2016 will be on implementing an accurate method to record gospel presentations.

M28 Vision: Make Disciples

Goal 7: Make 1,000 new disciples.

Progress: In 2015 we developed a baseline to determine at what point a new believer becomes a new disciple in a process we call *Be One Make One*. A goal for 2016 would be to encourage believer to help us know people who have become new disciples and to agree on a method to record someone hits the threshold of a new believer.

Goal 8: Start 100 new adult life groups, with an increasing emphasis on off-campus groups.

Progress: Since January 2015, we have begun 21 new life groups - 19 new adult life groups in English and 2 new life groups in Spanish. Of these 21 groups, 19 are still meeting. Currently about 30% of our adult life group attendance are meeting off campus.

Goal 9: Establishing an effective, intentional process to disciple people to be able to disciple other people. Rather than depending only on church programs as the sole method of discipleship, raising up mentors who would invest spiritually into lives in this community.

Progress: In 2015 we established a process for believers to begin discipling other believers called *Be One Make One*. *Be One Make One* resources may be found in the Inspiration Corner media center or online at www.anastasiabaptist.org/b1make1

GOAL 10: Focusing on teaching and supporting parents to be disciplers for their own children. An increased focus on healthy home life as a nursery for faith in Christ.

Progress:

- We are encouraged by church members who have begun a Home School Ministry group to encourage and support each other in discipling their children.
- Another step is a conference hosted by the ABC preschool ministry entitled “Motivating Your Child” and led by the National Association of Biblical Parenting. The conference is scheduled for Saturday July 23 and is focused on helping parents to disciple their children.

Goal 11: Adding a Senior Adult Pastor to reach and minister to the increased retired and semi-retired community.

Progress: A part-time position has been budgeted for 2016. The goal is to call a part-time senior adult pastor sometime this year.

Goal 12: Increasing our focus on family ministry and adding a Pastor of Discipleship and Family Ministries.

Progress: In November 2016 the church called Rev. Sam Thigpen to serve as Discipleship Pastor. Transition to this new position is in process.

Goal 13: Increase our ministry to youth by adding a Youth Pastor at the State Road 16 Campus.

Progress: Added a second worship service and our reaching an additional 50-60 people on a weekly basis in January 2015.

Goal 14: Increasing the quality of our facilities for family ministry at the island campus.

Progress: A master site plan committee is meeting currently. They have been tasked with bringing a site plan for church approval by the November 2016 congregation meeting. A request to establish a building committee and a fundraising committee will be made once the balance of the Together With God fund reaches \$500,000 for the Island Campus project. As of December 2016, we have received over \$143,000 for the Island Campus Project.

Goal 15: Raising up, training and sending out 25 Christian leaders to serve in churches and Christian ministry

Progress: Since September 2015, eight individuals trained at Anastasia Baptist Church or training support through ABC are now serving in other churches or ministries: Chris Aussem, Jeremy Bunnell, Lia Dalpini, Jamison Elder, Jim Friedel, Al Kaidor, Geraldo Ramirez, and Jessica Moore Rodrigues. Currently we have seven additional members who are in the process of preparing for ministry.
