Anastasia Baptist Church is honored to welcome Chaplain (Major) Pete Keough, who will bring the messages from the Word of God during the month of July (beginning July 7) at all the Saturday evening and Sunday morning worship services.

Chaplain Keough serves as Strategic Action Officer for the Chief of Chaplains' Strategic Initiatives and Integration Group at The Pentagon, Washington, DC. Chaplain Keough has also previously served as chaplain at Fort Polk, Louisiana; Fort Hood, Texas; Fort Carson, Colorado (with deployment to Afghanistan); and Bamberg, Germany (with deployment to Iraq). Prior military service culminated with 13 years as an enlisted Soldier and NCO in the Aviation Branch with deployments in support of Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm and contingency operations in Central and North America.

For his service to our country, Chaplain Keough has been awarded the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, and the Iraqi Campaign Medal, among many others.

He has earned the Bachelor of Arts, Theology, from The Baptist College of Florida; the Master of Divinity from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary; the Graduate Diploma, Military Strategy, from the US Army Command and General Staff College; and the Doctor of Ministry, from Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary.

The chaplain has served churches in Florida, Alabama, Louisiana, and Kentucky, as well as Army chapels in Louisiana, Colorado, Texas, Germany, Iraq, and Afghanistan. He is endorsed by the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention.

He is married to Amy (Mills) Keough of St. Augustine, Florida. They are the very proud parents of three children, Haden (23), Austin (21), and Kaitlyn (14). The Keoughs have been a part of the Anastasia family for many years. We are grateful for their service to our country and to our Lord.
